Team Letter

USA Volleyball enforces a ZERO TOLERANCE policy aimed to protect our officials, tournament staff, players, coaches and event spectators from any kind of harassment encountered during an event. Please report anything you encounter or witness to our championship desk staff, nearest official or event arbitrator IMMEDIATELY so we can perform a timely investigation and take appropriate action.

Tournament Manual

USA Volleyball holds ZERO TOLERANCE for any level of harassment towards our officials, tournament staff, players, coaches and spectators. The Harassment Incident Response – Officials & Staff (HIROS) Initiative was created as a response to the prevalent and increasing numbers of harassment incidents making headlines in sport. We have adopted a zero tolerance approach to this initiative at all qualifiers and national championships. The initiative's aim is to empower tournament staff to confidently respond and report incidents of harassment, <u>in real-time</u>, regarding hate speech directed toward an individual's ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, disability and / or physical violence. Please immediately report any kind of harassment encountered on-site to our officials, arbitrators, or tournament staff.

Coaches Meeting (pre-event talking points)

At this event, we are utilizing the USA Volleyball Harassment Incident Response – Officials & Staff (HIROS) Initiative. HIROS is specific to harassment that takes place at an event in the form of intentional physical contact (e.g. pushing, shoving, hitting) or hate speech that has to do with the slander of someone's racial, ethnic, or gender origin.
